NaloxBox Locations on the Outer Cape

What are NaloxBoxes?

NaloxBoxes are publicly accessible boxes that contain doses of **naloxone nasal spray**, medication that rapidly reverses opioid overdose, and instructions for use. Similar to automated external defibrillators (AED), the boxes allow bystanders to help save lives. Naloxone (or **NARCAN**) in NaloxBoxes is always free and available for anyone to take with them. These boxes are restocked on a regular basis in partnership with the AIDS Support Group of Cape Cod.
