STOP AN OVERDOSE

TAKE THESE STEPS:

Signs of overdosing:

CHECK FOR

OVERDOSE

- Not breathing well
- Turning blue/gray
- Not reacting when you rub your knuckles on their chest

Call 9-1-1

2 CALL 9-1-1


- Say "someone isn't breathing" and/or "I think it's an overdose"
- Stay until help arrives, even if they seem better*

• Push pump only after tip is in nose

3 GIVE NARCAN[®]

- Go to Step 4
- If no response in 3 minutes, give another dose

- Make sure mouth is clear
- Tilt head back, lift chin. pinch nose
- Give 1 breath every 5 seconds
- Try CPR if you've been trained



4 GIVE BREATHS/CPR

STAY UNTIL HELP ARRIVES

- If breathing well, put on side
- If not breathing well, repeat Steps 3 and 4
- Stay until help arrives*
